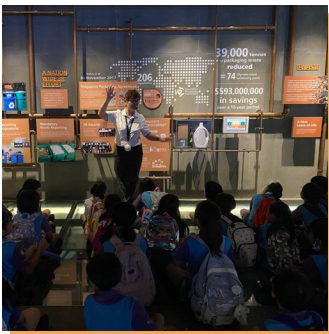

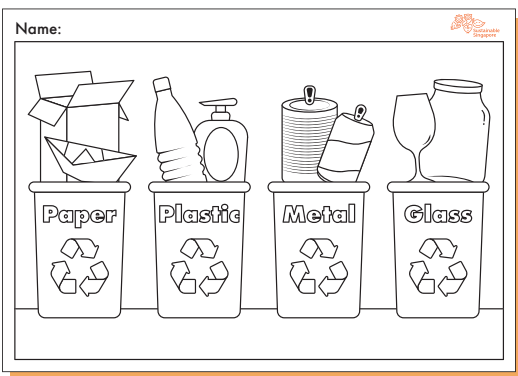


Gallery Tour

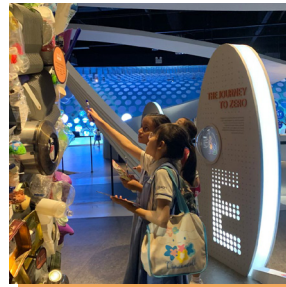


Gallery Overview

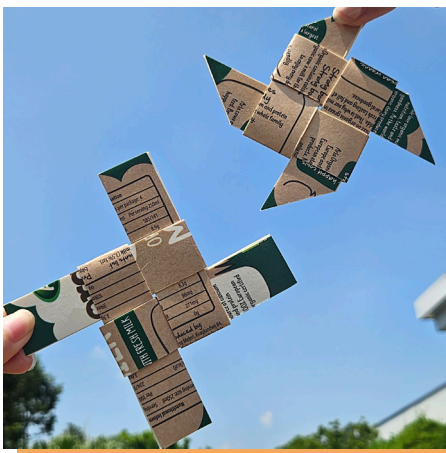
